

TIMEKEEPING

Swisstiming will provide the FIA GT Series timekeeping and results.

Driver identification system and transponders are required to be fitted to all cars for all sessions, to assist in the timing function and also to assist Race Control officials locating the position of cars on track for safety and administration purposes.

TYRES & FUEL DISPOSAL

We kindly remind you that it is forbidden to leave any tyres and/or fuel drums within the boundaries of the circuit (including the paddock, the pit lane and the pits). All the drums that will be delivered to you will be marked with your race number and you will have to give them back to Total or throw them away in a suitable place. Should a team fail to do so, it will be charged for the removal/cleaning costs.

PADDOCK

Pit garages are provided in return for a guarantee cheque of 500 €. An inventory will be taken, that will be checked when the keys for the garage are returned. Please find attached the rules and regulations for the pit garages, as well as the circuit internal regulations. Please note that the Circuit Paul Armagnac is private propriety, and therefore the internal regulations must be respected.

PADDOCK ENVIRONMENT

Please note that all the vehicles which will be parked inside the Paddock area, including trucks, cars, camping cars (including caravans), or any other vehicle with an engine <u>must protect the ground under the engine</u>. A <u>waterproof protection must be used</u> in order to protect and prevent any possible leak of oil/fuel or any other dangerous fluids into the environment (for example suitable protection would be a plastic protected by a carpet large enough to cover the ground under the fuel tank and engine). Should a team/supplier/Competitor fail to abide by this rule, a financial sanction will be imposed after the Event

TOTAL is the sole supplier of fuel for the FIA GT Series. Please find attached the specifications for the fuel for your information. The price for one litre of fuel is **3,35euros/litre**. **+ VAT**

As for payment the following procedure applies:

- -SRO will order the fuel for all Teams.
- Payments will have to be made on site by cash or by credit card.
- Accepted credit cards will be: International Visa and International Eurocard Mastercard only.
- Fuel should be delivered in drums. However we recommend you to always bring a couple of empty drums in case the fuel is delivered in bulk.

We would like to remind all the teams that the presentation of their garages, cars, trucks, drivers and team personal is very important. All the teams must fully respect the 2013 Sporting Regulations, its Appendix 1 and the Graphic Chart for the identification logo, the position of the stickers, pit panels.

These stickers will be available during the administrative checks.

ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS & SCRUTINEERING

The administrative checks will take place on Thursday from 14:00 to 18:00 and Friday from 09:00 to 12:00, on 1st floor of the Pit Building, in the circuit secretary's office.

All drivers and team managers have to sign on with the local ASN, presenting their licence and, where applicable, valid licences and/or authorizations issued by their ASN (including medical certificate for the Italian drivers) during the allocated time slots.

ENTRANTS: A copy of your 2013 licence will be required as well as the Visa of your National Sporting Authority if your licence is not issued by an European Sporting Federation (art. 70 of the FIA code)

DRIVERS: A copy of your 2013 licence will be required as well as the Visa of your National Sporting Authority if your licence is not issued by an European Sporting Federation (art. 70 of he FIA code).

We also kindly remind ALL the drivers that an International FIA C licence minimum is required,

ITALIAN DRIVERS: a medical certificate, a National Automobile Club membership cars and a « Scuola Federale CSAI

Velocita card » for the GT category min. 2000 is required.

Scrutineering will be conducted as follows:

- A) Safety checks to be conducted by the local ASN scrutineer in each team's pit garage.
- B) Scrutineering times for each competitor will be communicated soon

The final administrative checks timetable for the Team Managers will be sent soon.

All drivers' equipment (overall, helmet, gloves, balaclavas, HANS, fireproof underwear etc...) <u>MUST</u> be presented to the Technical Delegate during the scrutineering time.

REMEMBER that the CARBON HELMET as well as the HANS device are mandatory for drivers taking part in the FIA GT Series.

DRIVERS AND TEAM MANAGERS BRIEFING

A briefing will take place at 13:30 on Friday, March 29th 2013, at the circuit. The Briefing will be held in the Briefing room located on the 1^{sd} floor of the Pit Building.

- All team managers (or their representatives) and the drivers of those cars eligible to take part in the Meeting <u>must be present</u> throughout the briefing. Each driver and competitor must sign the attendance sheet at the entrance to the briefing room.

DRIVERS AUTOGRAPH SESSIONS (compulsory)

An Autograph Session for all drivers will take place Sunday, March 31st in the "Pit-lane at 12:00 and on Monday, April 1st in the paddock at 12:00. All Teams are welcome to bring their own posters/drivers cards.

Note that all teams must provide their own tables and chairs.

PODIUM CEREMONY
